PANEL WASH – ALKALINE STEAM DEGREASER

DESCRIPTION

PANEL WASH is a blend of selected alkaline salts and specialty surfactants, designed to remove grease and oil from a variety of substrates.

The substrates can vary from mild and stainless steels to aluminum and other alloys, to painted surfaces without damaging the substrate, providing the product is diluted according to directions.

PANEL WASH when diluted as per dilution schedule is considered to be a quick break degreaser.

DIRECTIONS

Spray the affected surface with ALKALINE STEAM DEGREASER PANEL WASH, allow to work, then flush away with water.

Note the water or system does not have to be hot or steam, but as with any chemical the process works faster when warmer.

Dilution guide 1 PART PANEL WASH with X parts water	
General use	75-100 parts
Engine cleaning/degreasing	10-20 parts
Removal of Bond breaker on Tilt slabs	3-5 parts
Removal of Surface Cure R Curing	3-4 parts
Compound	
Boat / deck wash	50 parts
Painted surface degreasing	75-120 parts
Heavy jobs	3-5 parts
